- When they go to school, they must wear boots because sometimes there are snakes in the cocoa orchards.





THE PEOPLE

- People bring the water from the well and they carry it home on their head.
- Stall roofs provide shade for the people during hot days.

THE VILLAGE

- In the village there are shops along the road.
- The houses are made of earth bricks and wood.
- The cocoa crops grow on the hills because the climate is cooler than in the village.
